The bearer hereof, CHRISTOPHER ANGELL, a Greeke borne in Peloponnesus, having been persecuted by the Turkes for his Religion, which by his Letters testimoniall appeareth, and for that cause was forced to leave his Countrey, came to Cambridge about Whitsontide 1608, and finding some reliefe, hath continued unto the day of the date hereof. During which time, his manner of life had been very honest and studious. Now, because he could not here have his health, being desirous to travell abroad into the Country, hee hath requested these our letters for a Testimonie of his honest behaviour, which we have willingly granted unto him, and set to our hands, this tenth of May 1610.
