

Βαρβάτος, οὐ, δ, the Latin *barbatus*, bearded.

Dion. H. IV, 2169, 3, as a surname. — Hence, not a eunuch. *Chron.* 627, 9. *Porph. Cer.* 62, 20.

Βαρβηλίται, ὄν, οι, *Barbelitae*, = following. *Epiph. I*, 337 A.

Βαρβηλώται, ὄν, οι, (*Βαρβηλώ*) *Barbeliotae*, certain heretics. *Theod. IV*, 361 C.

Βαρβηλώ, οὖς, ἡ, *Barbelo*, a Gnostic figment. *Iren.* 691 B. *Epiph. I*, 288 C. 321 C.

Βαρβηλώθ, ἡ, = preceding. *Theod. IV*, 361 C.

Βάρβιλος, see βράβιλος.

Βαρδάρης, η, δ, = **Βαρδάριος**. *Comm. I*, 239, 12.

Βαρδάριος, οὐ, δ, *Bardarius* = Ἀξίος, *Axius*. *Cedr. II*, 455, 7. *Nicot.* 666, 26.

Βαρδησάνης, οὐ, δ, *Bardesanes*, a Valentinian. *Eus. II*, 401 B. III, 464 A. *Theod. IV*, 372 B. *Tim. Presb.* 17 C. — Called also Ἀρδησάνης. *Hippol. Haer.* 286, 13; perhaps an error.

Βαρδησιανισταί, ὄν, οι, *Bardesianistae*, the followers of Bardesanes. *Adam.* 1792 C. *Epiph. I*, 848 D.

Βάρδοι, ὄν, οι, *bardi*, bards, the *δοιδοί* of the Gauls. *Posidon.* apud *Athen.* 6, 49. *Diod.* 5, 31. *Strab.* 4, 4, 4.

Βαρδούκιον, οὐ, τὸ, = ρόπαλον, a mace, club. *Leo. Tact.* 6, 27. 7, 58. *Theoph. Cont.* 232.

Βαρέα, βαρεῖα, see βαρύς.

Βαρέω, ήσω, = **βαρύνω**. *Sept. Ex.* 7, 14 **Βεβάστηται** ἡ καρδία Φαραώ. *Parth.* 9, p. 10, 21. **Αἰς βαρηθεῖσα** ἡ πάις. *Dion. H.* I, 37, 7. *Philon I*, 373, 20 **Βεβαρημένων** καὶ **πεπιεσμένων** οἴνῳ. *Matt.* 26, 43. *Marc.* 14, 40 as v. l. *Luc.* 9, 32. 21, 34. *Paul. Cor.* 2, 1, 8, 2, 5, 4. *Tim.* 1, 5, 16. *Muson.* 207. *Jos.* 15, 3, 3. *Ignat.* 701 B, τινά. *Epict.* 1, 9, 14. *Anton.* 8, 44. 36 -σθαί τινα. *Lucian.* III, 573. *App. I*, 207, 1. *Galen.* II, 271 D. *Herodin.* 8, 8, 2 'Εβαρούντο τε αὐτῶν αὐτὴν τὴν εὐγένειαν. *Greg. Nyss.* III, 117 B. II, 29 A

Πρὸς κακίαν **βαρήσας** καὶ κατανεύσας, neuter. *Chrys.* VII, 68 A **Βαρούμενος** τὴν αὐτόθι διατριβήν. *Aster.* 208 D Τῇ ἐπὶ πλέον ζωῇ τοῦ γέρωντος **βαρούμενος**. [The Attics use only βεβαρημένος. Homer has 2 perf. βεβαρήώς, neuter. Lucian (in the passage referred to) condemns the use of βαρέω for βαρύνω.]

***βαρέως** (**βαρύς**), adv. heavily, etc. Classical. Tropically, overbearingly, oppressively. *Sept. Macc.* 3, 3, 1. *Diod.* 11, 48. 15, 28. — **2.** With the grave accent, that is, with no accent. *Aristot. Elench.* 21. *Apollon. D. Pron.* 364 B. *Athen.* 2, 40.

Βαρζαμαράται or **βαρζαμαράται**, οι, Persian officers. *Mal.* 271, 7. 22.

Βάρημα, ατος, τὸ, (**βαρέω**) = **βάρος**. *Dion. H.* IV, 2029, 8 as v. l. *Theogn. Mon.* 853 D.

Βάρησις, εως, ἡ, a weighing down, heaviness. *Iambl.* Adhort. 326.

Βάρις, εως, ἡ, Hebrew בִּירָה = πύργος, tower, castle. *Sept. Esdr.* 1, 6, 22. 2, 6, 2. *Ps. 44, 9. Jos. Ant.* 10, 11, 7. 11, 4, 6. 12, 4, 11.

Βάρκα, ας, ἡ, *barca*, bark, boat. *Lyd.* 180, 11. *Isid. Hisp.* 19, 1, 19.

Βάρκας, α, δ, *Barcas*. *Polyb.* 1, 74, 9.

Βαρκηνίμ = **βρκנִים** = **τρίβολα**, threshing sledges. *Sept. Judic.* 8, 7.

Βάρνα, ας, ἡ, *Varna*, a city in Bulgaria. *Theoph.* 549. *Nic. CP. Histor.* 40, 7. *Cedr.* II, 555, 4.

Βαρνάβας, α, δ, *Barnabas*. *Eus.* II, 117 B. *Theod. Lector* 184 B.

Βάρος, eos, τὸ, L. *gravitas*, disagreeableness of smell. *Diosc.* 4, 76. — **2.** Weight, in the sense of power, authority. *Diod.* 4, 61. 15, 62, τῆς Σπάρτης. *Paul. Thess.* 1, 2, 6. — **3.** Overbearing conduct, oppression. *Diod.* 20, 55. — **4.** Weight of character. *Plut.* II, 522 E. — **5.** Burden, tax. *Leo. Novell.* 220, δημοσιακά, public burdens.

Βαρούχ, δ, indeclinable, *Baruch*. *Sept. Baruch* 1, 1. — **Βαρούχ βιβλος**, the book of *Baruch*, a Gnostic forgery. *Hippol. Haer.* 216, 35. *Orig. I*, 195 C.

Βάρρων, ανος, δ, see Ονάρρων, *Varro*.

Βαρσανούφιος, οὐ, δ, *Barsanuphius*. *Tim. Presb.* 45 A.

Βαρσανούφιται, ὄν, οι, *Barsanuphite*, the followers of Barsanuphius, a branch of the Acephali. *Tim. Presb.* 45 A. *Damasc.* I, 756 B.

Βαρναλγία, ας, ἡ, (**βαρναλγής**) deep suffering. *Germ.* 269 B.

Βαρνύλωσσος, οὐ, (**βαρύς, γλῶσσα**) = **βαθύγλωσσος**. *Sept. Ezech.* 3, 5 as v. l. *Orig. III*, 773 C. *Theod.* II, 844 B.

***βαρύδιον**, οὐ, τὸ, (**βάρος**) small weight. *Heron* 193, 197.

Βαρυεγκέφαλος, οὐ, (**έγκεφαλος**) heavy-brained, thick-headed. *Plut.* II, 1086 E.

Βαρυεργής, ές, (**ΕΡΓΩ**) hard to move. *App. II*, 115, 35.

Βαρυήκοος, οὐ, hard of hearing. *Orig. IV*, 232 B.

Βαρύχος, οὐ, (**χήος**) sounding heavily. *Agath.* 294, 8. *Bekker.* 225, 18 **Βαρύχος**, μεγαλόχος, μεγαλόφοφος, μεγάλοκτυπος.

Βαρυθυμέω, ήσω, (**βαρύθυμος**) to be wroth, indignant, or dejected. *Sept. Num.* 16, 15. *Reg.* 3, 11, 22. *Diod.* 20, 41, ἐπὶ τῷ πάθει. *Plut.* I, 454 A. II, 739 E -σθαι. *App. I*, 39, 30. 338, 90. II, 822, 14.

Βαρυθυμία, ας, ἡ, indignation, dejection. *Jos. Ant.* 16, 10, 5. *Plut.* II, 477 E, et alibi. *Oenom.* apud *Eus.* III, 396 B. *Clementin.* 333 A.
